Nursing Program Advisories:

The rigorous coursework and time commitment of the registered nursing program make it difficult for most students to work more than 16 hours per week. Courses are scheduled seven days per week, usually between the hours of 0600 and 2300 within Monterey County. Students are responsible for academic supplies, transportation, living expenses, and, if applicable, dependable childcare. Students are encouraged to apply for financial aid and/or scholarships through Hartnell College Financial Aid Services. Approximately 85% of nursing students receive financial assistance.
