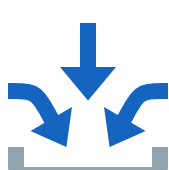

How well do we do what we are doing & how do we improve?

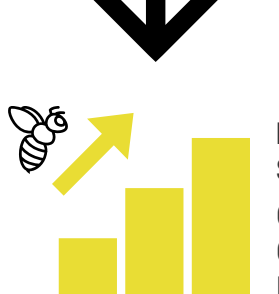
