## Accreditation visit in March 2019

### Hartnell receives a commendation on assessment!

“The team commends the College for creating a campus culture that values assessment as a process for improving programs and courses. Faculty have embraced student learning outcomes assessment and use the evaluation process as a way to enact meaningful change (II.A.2, II.A.3, II.A.16).”



## Seven year cycle

- **Years 1 - 3**
  - Course level assessment
  - All courses assessed at least once
- **Year 4**
  - A focused look at the program level
- **Years 5 - 7**
  - Course level assessment with opportunity to see if interventions have made a difference



## 2018 - 2019

- Accreditation visit - sigh of relief!

## 2019 - 2020

- Year 4 - the year of the PPA/PLO
- March of spring semester . . . COVID

## 2020 - 2021

- Fall of 2020 - advised not to assess due to transition to online
- Spring 2021 - some courses assessed but not many completed

## 2021 - 2022

- Fall 2021 - more courses scheduled for assessment but many not completed



## Spring 2021

- **187 scorecards sent out**
  - 103 completed
  - 84 not completed
  - 55% completion rate

## Fall 2021

- **340 scorecards sent out**
  - 168 completed
  - 172 not completed
  - 49% completion rate



## Follow-up with faculty

- Reminders to faculty to enter data if available for Fall 2021
- Complete action plans from Spring 2021 and Fall 2021
  - Currently set up virtually in folders on Google Drive
- Reschedule assessment for courses as needed
- Three semesters left to get the work done!



## Getting all courses assessed

- Impacts the Year 4 program level activities
- Discussion at O & A committee of how to ensure this is done
- Recommendation to be made to Academic Senate and Academic Affairs Council
