Understanding Technical Requirements

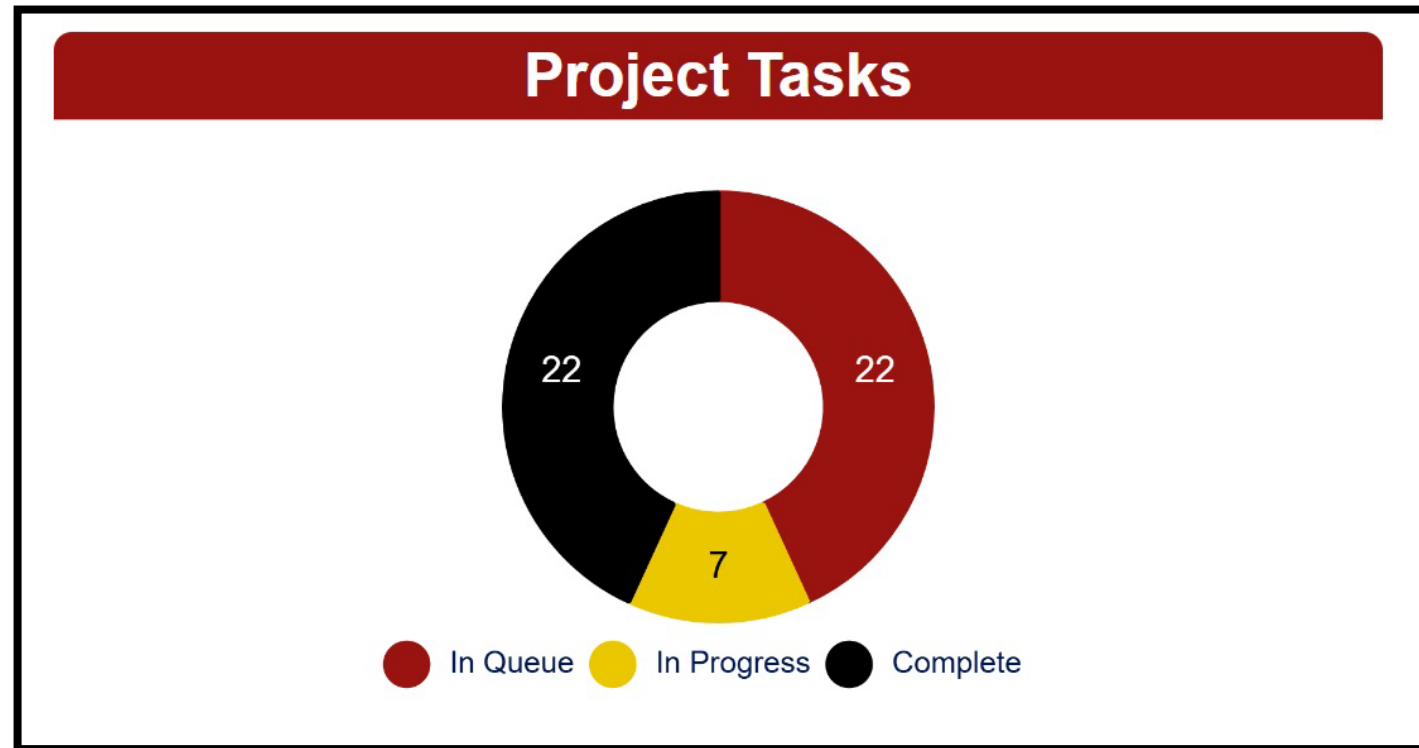
- First Bachelor's degree being implemented at Hartnell
