  - Complete the Hartnell College Online Orientation
  - Obtain course placement for both English and math

**Note:** 12th Grade Dual Enrollment Students (AB288-CCAP) are eligible for Priority registration on May 11th.

  - April 29th-May 15th
  - Counselor/CPT Facilitate
  - 1.5 hours: morning, afternoon, evening, Saturdays
  - 30 students per workshop
  - Approx 40 workshops (in less than 3 weeks)



- Ensure students understand how to select courses for their first semester
- Become familiar with the Ed-planner and place courses in their “cart”
- Are prepared to log-in and complete their registration May 18th
