4.01 Participatory Governance VP Rivera Discussion/Action

This item is for members of the ASHC to give a report regarding their assigned councils and committees

Accreditation Council - Bryan and Dulce - discussion about the next ISER and the midterm was finished. They're going to have more ASHC in the ISER. There's going to be a change in new policies, and the draft will be presented to the Board of Directors

Student Affairs - Oscar - doesn't have a report because the meeting is going on right now during the student council meeting.

Technology Council - David - A point was made that the IT department was too small to handle the many needs of our students and faculty. Some issues included students not able to access their CatCard funds, and the DUO system having problems with the overwhelming MFA notifications affecting student text message services

Diversity Committee - Dulce - next week on Monday

Laura - The committee didn't meet quorum. Contact them regarding any information.

Administrative Business Services - Daniel - security issue on campus with some guy walking around campus and entering the women's bathroom. They're working on a security solution, a new sec director. if students aren't in those classes or after hours, the buildings are going to be closed for added security. There was an update of budget information. Governance redesign was also discussed. A student suffered an asthma attack, but no one was there. After 5 minutes, no one came. Veterans came out, but the asthma person became non-vocal. EMS arrived shortly after security, and security should respond immediately, especially for a student's medical emergency. Elijah felt the suspicious person entering the women's bathroom was alarming and warrants a warning system that should be discussed and added to the next agenda item.
